NATIONAL NIGHT OUT

August 6, 2013

WHEREAS, The National Association of Town Watch (NATW) is sponsoring a unique, nationwide crime, drug and violence prevention program on August 6, 2013, entitled 'National Night Out'; and

WHEREAS, "National Night Out" provides a unique opportunity for the City of Kelso to join forces with thousands of other communities across the country in promoting cooperative, police and community crime prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, it is important that all citizens of Kelso be aware of the importance of crime prevention programs and the positive impact that their participation can have on reducing crime and drugs in our neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, neighborhood spirit and cooperation is the theme of the "National Night Out" project and plays an important role in helping the Kelso Police Department fight the war on crime and drugs in our community; and

WHEREAS, this initiative is much more than a single night, as it symbolizes a strong partnership between communities and law enforcement united in the common cause of public safety, intolerant of crime in all its forms, generating support for local anti-crime programs;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, David Futcher, Mayor of the City of Kelso, formally declare August 6, 2013, as "National Night Out", and encourage all citizens of the City of Kelso to shine their lights and add their voices to the outcry against criminal acts that compromises the quality of life in our City.
